If you would like to gain access to percussion studio spaces and instruments for personal practicing you need to:

1. Audition for Mr. Coley to be accepted into the percussion studio and school of music in a music degree program; ie. Bachelors of Music in Performance or Education, or Bachelors of Arts in Music.
AND/OR
2. Perform in a university ensemble; Marching Band, Jazz Bands or Combos, Percussion Ensemble, Wind Ensemble, Concert Band, Symphonic Band, or Orchestra.

If you would like to take percussion lessons you need to (118, 119, 218, 219, 319...):

1. Audition for Mr. Coley to be accepted into the percussion studio and school of music in a music degree program; ie. Bachelors of Music in Performance or Education, or Bachelors of Arts in Music.
OR
2. Perform in a university ensemble and when Mr. Coley has extra time in his studio schedule he will contact you about lessons.
OR
